PURPOSE

The purpose of implementing a school uniform is to:

1. Promote a sense of belonging and pride within the school and local community.
2. Establish a distinctive identity for the school.
3. Offer a variety of choices to cater to diverse student preferences for different activities while ensuring adherence to health and safety standards.

4. Foster a sense of equity among the students by eliminating competition related to brand name/fashion clothing.

The Governing Council has granted approval for the uniform policy and expects student compliance, with support from parents and staff vital to enforce it effectively.

PREFACE

Valley View Secondary School uniforms are provided by Uniform Management Services (UMS). All members of the school community work in partnership to support students in the wearing of the school uniform.

A student shall wear the full and correct uniform when on school grounds, travelling to and from the school and at all school organised activities such as graduation ceremonies, unless informed otherwise by the staff member(s) responsible for the activity.

A student shall wear the school sports uniform only when engaged in sporting activity during the day.

Accommodations made in variation to the uniform can be considered as part of a documented One Plan or Health Care Plan. These cases will be considered on an individual basis. Parents and Caregivers are encouraged to contact the Wellbeing Team if provision of uniform causes financial hardship.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q Can the VVSS Formal Uniform be worn in combination with Sports Uniform?

A The sports polo must not be worn with the formal pants, formal shorts, dress or skirt. The knitted jumper/puffer jacket can be worn with the sports uniform for warmth. The sports uniform can only be worn on days when students are engaging in PE practicals or school sports carnivals.

Q What kind of footwear must students wear to meet WHS requirements for safety during school activities?

A Students are required to wear plain black lace-up or plain black sports shoes to ensure durability for activities involving chemicals, machinery, sharp objects and physical exertion on various surfaces.

Q Are 'leggings' considered a part of the school uniform?

A No, 'leggings' are not considered as stockings/tights and are not a part of the uniform. Students may wear stockings under the school skirt and school dress for additional warmth or modesty reasons.

Q Can compression tights may be worn under the sports uniform for extra warmth or modesty?

A Yes, provided they are plain navy blue or black.

Q Are students allowed to wear jewellery as part of the school uniform?

A Discrete jewellery that ensures the personal safety of our students is acceptable. The school also understands the importance of jewellery of cultural significance or sentimental value to some students, and these items may be worn under the school uniform, provided they remain invisible at all times. Medic Alert jewellery is exempted.

Q Can students dye their hair an unnatural colour?

A Dyeing hair an unnatural colour is discouraged as the school is preparing students for professional expectations.

Q What is the school's policy on makeup and nail polish?

A Discrete makeup and nail polish are acceptable as part of the school uniform guidelines.

Q What should I do if my child has sensory needs and finds it challenging to wear the standard school uniform?

A The school understands that some students may have sensory needs that make wearing the standard uniform uncomfortable. In such cases, we are committed to working with families to find suitable uniform modifications or alternatives that ensure your child's comfort and accommodate their specific sensory requirements.
